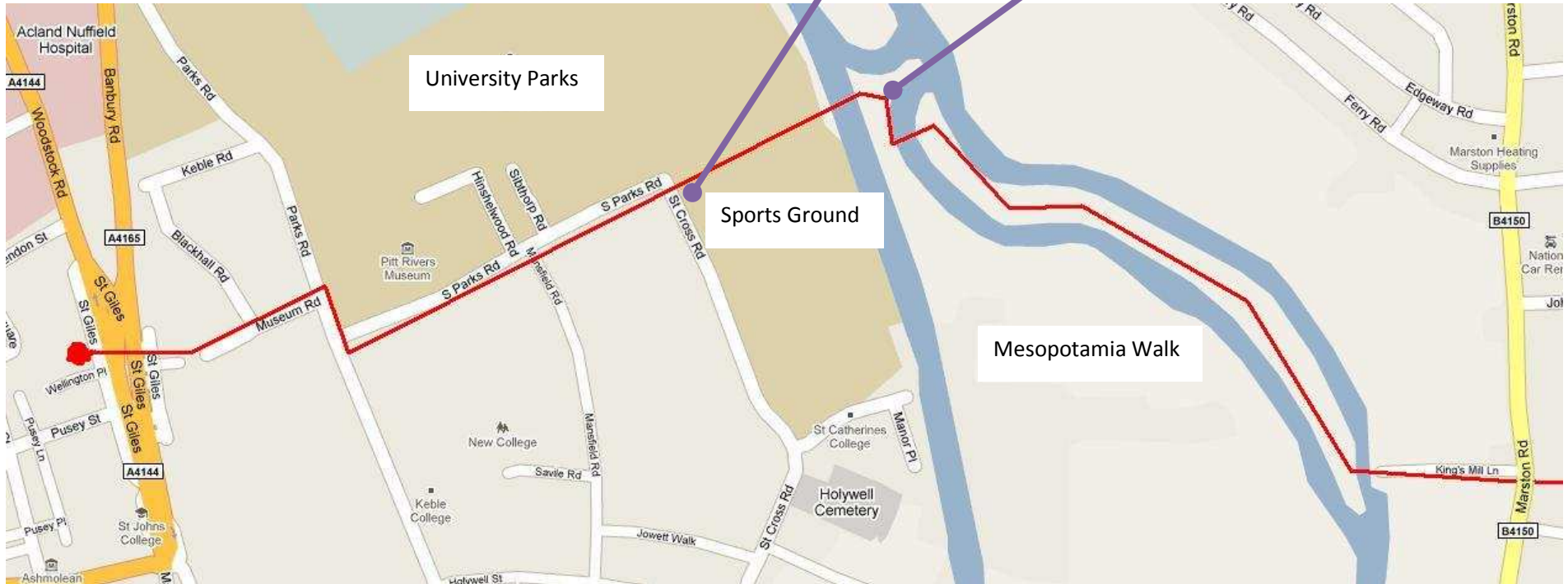


Walking between Oxford and Headington Meetings

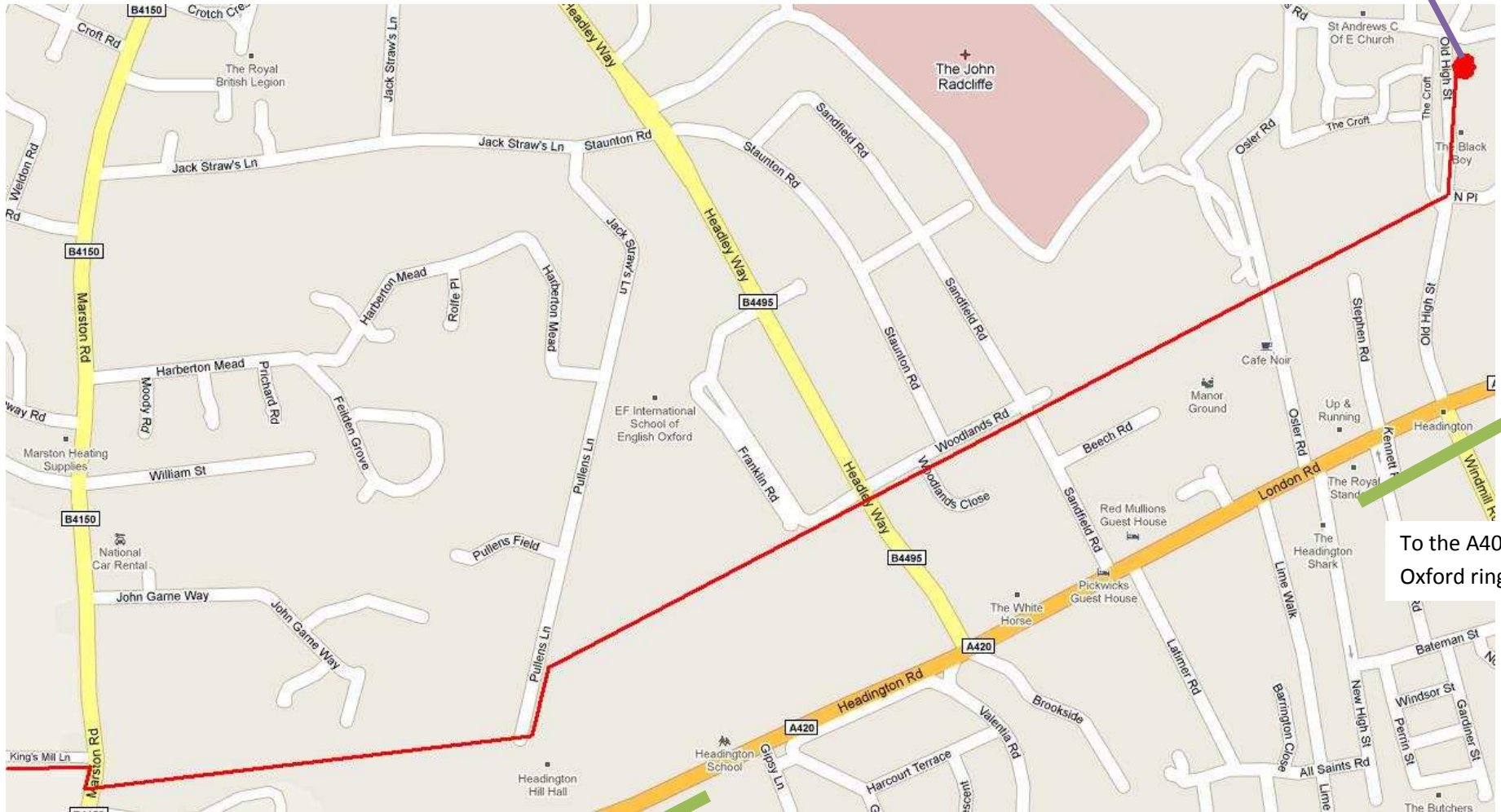
Headington and Oxford Meetings are separated by 2.2 miles (3.5 km) as the crow flies. You can walk between the two in about an hour, along approximately three miles of what are mostly small paths. Head east from **Oxford Meeting** on St Giles – below, this is indicated with a red circle on the left. Soon after Linacre College, a tall kissing gate leads to Mesopotamia Walk. Follow this walk to Marston Road.

Cross Marston Road and continue, climbing a footpath. Later, after leaving Woodlands Road, you'll be on a small passage called Cuckoo Lane, which emerges onto the Old High Street. **Headington Meeting** worships in the chapel of the Priory there, opposite the Baptist Church.
